## A Petition To The US House And Senate: Please Pass The Fair Labeling and Informed Consent Act

The Fair Labeling and Informed Consent Act (FLICA) would require unambiguous package labeling to all consumers, medical professionals, pharmacists and public health officials whenever aborted fetal or embryonic materials are used in medical products to allow selection of alternatives in advance of purchase. FLICA is consistent with existing Federal Law requiring clear, non-evasive language in consumer packaging and labeling practices, including but not limited to 21 CFR Part 20, 42 USC, § 300aa-26, the Federal Food, Drug and Cosmetic Act, 502 (e), USC Title 15, Ch. 39, §1451; 41 FR 6908, Sec. 201.10 Drugs, and 502(e) of the FDAC Act. FLICA upholds the USC principle that, "Informed consumers are essential to the fair and efficient functioning of a free market economy." It only makes sense that if the FDA can require fat content to be disclosed in food shouldn't consumers know the ingredients in the medicines they are purchasing?

We the undersigned, urge you to enact this sensible, bi-partisan legislation that will open the market to competing companies, stimulate the economy, provide new jobs and restore consumer confidence in the pharmaceutical industry and government.
