Just saying 'NO' is not sufficient when people's loved ones are suffering from disease. At Sound Choice we say 'YES' to ethical alternatives. We are discovering and developing better, safer, ethically produced drugs and medicines because we care about the health of others.

The recent exposé of Planned Parenthood callously discussing the sale of aborted fetuses illustrates two important precepts for me. 1) A picture paints a thousand words, and 2) a small group of people and their supporters can make a huge international impact. As I shared in our fall newsletter, it was the work of Sound Choice that brought the human exploitation for biomedical research to the attention of The Center for Medical Progress, who made the videos that exposed that brutal harvesting of pre-born children up to the age of viability. I have been 'telling' people about the exploitation of aborted fetuses and other vulnerable human beings, but it took the pictures in the videos to make it 'real' for many. If we were not here, if you had not supported us, the world would not know about what has been done. Thank you for allowing us to shed light on human exploitation scientific research and biomedical in development.

We need your ongoing support, in 2016 and beyond, to continue to call on scientists and doctors to think about what they are doing when they use materials from aborted babies and vulnerable human beings.

Excuses and justification for the barbaric harvesting of fetal body parts came within a few months after the first video was The first justification was the released. erroneous claim that use of fetal tissue had been necessary and critical for the development of vaccines for rubella and polio. Right or Wrong? WRONG! A few scientists chose to use the remains of aborted fetuses for their vaccine work while the majority took viral samples from living people without doing any harm and used existing animal cell lines to make rubella and polio vaccines. Not only were vaccines made without exploiting any other human being, these ethically produced vaccines have been proven to be as effective and safer than the vaccines made from aborted fetuses.

When the lie that vaccines could only have been produced with aborted fetal tissue did not persuade the public, respected institutions began to come forward and admit that they use fresh aborted fetal tissue in their research. Does the fact that a respected institution subscribes to such barbaric practices make it OK? NO!

Reach out to institutions wherever you live that have admitted they use aborted fetal tissue for research, and ask them to search their hearts. Tell them that they are better than that. Remind them that the baby's bodies they are harvesting were often aborted beyond the age of viability and could have survived outside the womb.

On October 31, 2015 The Seattle Times published an article about survival of premature babies and the news that national and international experts have lowered the age for resuscitation down to 22 weeks gestation because babies born at this age can survive without serious problems. Scientists at Paul Allen's Allen Institute for Brain Science have published papers based on research on brains from 22 week gestation babies. From the Planned Parenthood exposé videos we know that the perfectly intact brain pictured in the Allen Institute for Brain Science paper may have been harvested by cutting through the face of a 22 week old baby with a beating heart. Why would a respected institution like Seattle Children's, an institution supposed to improve the health of children, do research on the heart tissue of aborted babies 8-19 weeks of age?
